



Jensen Interceptor.

The car, a 1974, was completely restored (with no bondo) and then epoxy clear coated 4 years ago. I had the wheels turned down and epoxyed and a new air-con compressor. I have the receipts. Chrome, tires, glass, etc etc are all good and are show-car quality. The tires are hardly worn. The odometer shows almost 80,000 miles. The engine (Chrysler 440 High Performance) and transmission were all checked out and tuned and it runs well and strong and shifts smoothly. The only flaws are the passenger's seat has a crack in the leather. Call this patina.

It won best of show at the Wellbrooke show the last time I entered it and it came second to an exotic model of Jensen I have never seen before at the 2009 Vancouver ABFM and a first at the Seattle All British 2 years ago. It is as good as it gets and I hate to see it go.

Original owners' manual, jack and tool roll etc go with it as well as aftermarket maintenance and parts manuals, and a box of 8 track tapes.

I am asking \$17,400 and the reason for selling is I am downsizing and I have lost my garage. It is located in Tsawwassen.
